Directions to Pheasant Run Resort - 4051 E Main St, St Charles, IL 60174

From the North: I-94 E and I-294 S to IL-64 W/North Ave in Lombard. Take the IL-64/North Ave exit from I-355 S. Follow North Ave and E N Ave to your destination in St. Charles 21 min (11.4 mi).

From the North West: I-90 E to N Randall Rd in Dundee Township. Take the Randall Rd exit from I-90 E. Get on US-20 E in Elgin 7 min (3.7 mi). Merge onto US-20 E 4 min (3.5 mi). Take IL-25 S, Dunham Rd, N Kirk Rd and IL-64 E/E Main St to your destination in St. Charles.

From the West: I-88 E to N Farnsworth Ave in Aurora Township. Take the Farnsworth Ave S exit from I-88 E. Take Kirk Rd to your destination in St. Charles.

From the East: I-80 W/I-94 W: Continue on I-80 W. Take I-294 N to IL-64 W/North Ave in Lombard. Take the IL-64/North Ave exit from I-355 N. Follow North Ave and E N Ave to your destination in St. Charles.

From the South: I-65 N: Take I-294 N to IL-64 W/North Ave in Lombard. Take the IL-64/North Ave exit from I-355 N. Follow North Ave and E N Ave to your destination in St. Charles.

From the Southwest: I-55 N to IL-59 N in Naperville. Take exit 123 from I-88 W. Continue on IL-59 N to your destination in St. Charles.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.
