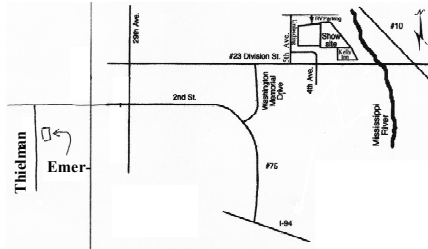


## ROUTE TO SHOW

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule printed in this program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show-giving Club and Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Being an unbenched show, you need to be at show only in time for your judging and may leave any time after judging. Numbers before each Breed represent the number of dogs entered in (1) the regular dog classes; (2) regular bitch classes; (3) Specials Only, Best of Breed or Best of Variety Competition; and in (4) Non-Regular classes.

- No private exercise pens will be allowed. Please conserve space & stack crates and other items. Roping off of areas will not be allowed. **NO PRIVATE EX-PENS AT ANY TIME, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- The St. Cloud Rivers' Edge Convention Center does not allow food to be brought into the building. This includes forms of cooking, pot-lucks, snack tables, etc.

### EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

**Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

***"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."***

### ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dogs over 6 months need a Rabies Vaccination and Certificate. The vaccine must be given by a Veterinarian. The vaccination is recognized for the duration of immunity as stated on the vaccine vial and should be on the certificate. There is no difference between live and killed vaccines in this context.
