SHOW SITE

The Show Grounds at this Show constitute the entire fairgrounds.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after the Show Superintendent sets up Wednesday, November 15, 2017 at 2:00 PM. Building will be locked Wednesday at 8:00 PM. NO DOGS in building overnight. The building will be opened at 7:00 am Thursday through Saturday. On these days, the building will be locked 30 minutes after the last event. Dogs and crates must be removed from the show site 1/2 hour following the Top 20 Banquet Saturday, November 18, 2017. The doors will be locked **30 minutes** after the conclusion of each day's events. All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee of this show giving club on these days will be strictly enforced, but not limited to that which is recorded in the premium list.

GROOMING & VENDING area will be in the same building as the Show. In the free grooming area, crates must be stacked and there is NO electric available. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates. Exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean will be asked to leave. Dogs may be exercised only in designated areas outside the show building.

You are welcome to bring your own exercise pens but they must be set up in designated places. Exercise Pens are not to be left unattended. This will be strictly enforced. Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (i.e. left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS AT ALL TIMES, including in the ring. Pooper scoopers and trash cans will be available. Not cleaning up after your dog will result in action (including a Bench Show Hearing) from the Show Committee. This includes any complaints received from Hotels. Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the rest room sinks and toilets is prohibited. NO DOGS will be allowed in the rest rooms. Dog bathing facilities will be available outside the building; please do not bath dogs in the restrooms.

PARKING There is a **30 minute** loading and unloading time limit. All parking will be on a first come, first serve basis. Extra spaces may not be saved by roping off, using empty crates, exercise pens, chairs or any equipment. Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate vehicles. All vehicles will be parked at the owner's risk and the American Brittany Club will NOT BE responsible for loss by fire, burglary, theft or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

- The American Brittany Club National Specialty Show, with the exception of dogs registered with an ILP/PAL number, and dogs under the age of 2 years at the start of the event (2012).

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS-This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

VETERAN CLASS- For Dogs & Bitches eight (8) years of age or older.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered in the Veteran Dog Class and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Bitch Class at Independent Specialties.

DUAL CHAMPION CLASS - For Dogs & Bitches that are Dual Champion of record as of the date of closing of the show.

FIELD TRIAL CLASS- For Dogs & Bitches that are Field Trial or Amateur Field Trial Champions or dogs that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial during the current year beginning with the closing date of entries for the previous year's National Specialty Show through the closing date of the present year. The date, name of trial & placement must be included with the entry form, see entry form, or the class will not be processed. *If entering online an email should be sent to rjds@royjonesdogshows.com with the dogs AKC # and information required above clearly listed.*

NOTE: Dogs & Bitches Placing First in the Veteran Classes, Field Trial Classes & Dual Champion Classes Shall be Eligible to Compete in the Best of Breed Competition provided they have not been defeated in any other class.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than four of his Get. Owners of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owners of the Get. Get MUST BE entered in another class in this Show. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under The Dog Show rules.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: As the judge's decision will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes. **Note:** Chapter 11, Section 8 of The Dog Show rules provides that castrated males may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dogs Class and Spayed Bitches as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

AWARDS OF MERIT - The judge, at their own discretion, may award up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry Awards of Merit.

BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES: For First Place winners in the Regular Puppy Classes 6-9 month Dogs and Bitches and 9-12 month Dogs and Bitches. Best Puppy will be selected following the judging of Best of Breed & Awards of Merit Competition.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR IN REGULAR CLASSES: For First Place winners in the Regular Bred-By-Exhibitor Dog Class and Bred-by-Exhibitor Bitch Class. Best Bred-by-Exhibitor will be selected following the judging of Best of Breed & Awards of Merit Competition.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2017

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show.*

PARADE OF CHAMPIONS AND TITLE HOLDERS

All Brittanys who have earned a title are eligible for the Parade, for which a fee of \$25.00 will be charged (\$15.00 as an additional entry). Entry form must state "PARADE". Rosettes with dog's name inscribed will be offered to all participants in the Parade. Rosettes must be claimed the day of the show. Rosettes will not be mailed. Please send a typewritten write-up of NO MORE than 100 words about your dog and turn into the Show Chairman 24 hours prior to the scheduled Parade of Champions.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
