The purpose of the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
 - Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show.
 - Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
 - Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner Handled Series competition.
 - Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- Dogs declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
 - If the Best of Breed winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
 - If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
 - If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner Handled Best of Breed.
 - If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series competition, Owner Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded.

Judging for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Best in Breed may take place prior to or after regular Best in Breed judging.

 11 years & older.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 "Rules Applying to Dog Shows"
 provide that a neutered male or spayed bitch may be entered as a veteran.

Winners of the above classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition.

AMATEUR-OWNER-HANDLER CLASS (effective as of 1/1/2009)

Chapter 3, Section 7 – The Amateur-Owner-Handled class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13.

BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY:(1) All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. (2) Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog and (3) Family member must be a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in this class.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION (No defeated dogs will be allowed to compete) The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed: Dogs that are Champions of record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

RESERVE WINNERS – DOG & BITCH (National Specialty)

The ACKCSC, as provided by the AKC, will designate the Reserve Winners Dog and the Reserve Winners Bitch to be awarded a three (3) point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners sex totals at least twice the number required for a five (5) point major in the region in which this event is held. No Major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners. In counting the number of dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included.

I MADE THE CUT for National Specialty Only

For Regular classes with an entry of 12 or more. If the judge makes a "cut" to limit the number of exhibits under consideration for placement, those exhibits remaining after the last and final cut that do not place will be awarded an "I Made the Cut" t-shirt.

SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS...

BEST PUPPY-During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and the 9 mos. and under 12 mos. Classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete**.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR-During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Bred-by-Exhibitor in each Breed from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete**.

BEST VETERAN-During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran in Breed from the Non-Regular Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch Classes. This will be done after Best of Breed & Award of Merit judging. Example: A Veteran Class winner is awarded Best of Breed then Best Veteran award is automatic. Only dogs **not defeated** in regular Veteran classes are eligible to compete for Best Veteran.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES for National Specialty Only

At the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes a will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and **two of their Get**. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Brace Class—Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. **PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.**

A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

OPEN CLASS—For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS—This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler: The American Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, Inc. will offer a prize for Best Junior Handler provided there is a minimum of two class winners present to compete for the prize. The Junior Handler who has placed first in each regular Junior Showmanship Class, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize.

Reserve Best Junior Handler: The American Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, Inc., will offer a prize for the Reserve Best Junior Handler, provided there is a minimum of two class winners present to compete for the prize. After the judge has awarded Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler with the remaining eligible class winners.

- The remaining seventy-five percent (75%) of the total purse shall be divided according to the percentage of the total entry represented by the number of Cavaliers entered in each class. As an example: Total Futurity Stakes entry = 100, entry in 6-9mos. Bitches = 10; therefore 10/100 = 10%. As a result – 10% of the remaining purse is awarded in the 6-9mos bitch class.
- Rosettes shall be awarded for placements of First – Fourth place in each class. Additionally, Rosettes shall be given to the Best in Futurity, Best Senior in Futurity and Best Junior in Futurity. Qualifying Scores will be Required For All Prizes In Regular Classes.

A Dark Green Qualifying Score Rosette will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score.

A Refund of all but \$10.00 of the entry fee will be refunded for bitches entered in Rally that come in season after the entries close. A Veterinarian's certificate must be presented to the Show Superintendent no later than 1/2 hour prior to the start of the 1st class in the Trial.

Transfers will be allowed for each Trial per AKC Regulations.



AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

A RECORDING FEE of 50¢, and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes will be collected. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
