**Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs**

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

**EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE**

**Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

**No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.**

**• NOTE •**

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.

Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

Dogs are not required to be at the show until scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

**ENTRY FEES & LIMITS**

**NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE EVENT, ONLY THE FIRST EVENT WILL BE PROCESSED.**

ENTRY FEE is \$25.00 for the first entry of each dog. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

ENTRIES CLOSE at the Office of Roy Jones Dog Shows, Inc., **WEDNESDAY NOON (EDT), JULY 11, 2018**, unless limits have reached prior to this date, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

MAKE CHECKS and Money Orders payable to Roy Jones Dog Shows, Inc. (Returned Check Charge \$40.00). All Checks Must Have Show(s) & Breed(s) entered written on the face. **THIRD PARTY CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!**

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED with checks drawn on U.S. Institutions or with International Money Orders in U. S. Funds.

**EXPO RULES AND RV GUIDELINES**

**THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to a show committee hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club.

- **The only vehicles allowed within the show area (within 50' of all rings), are First Aid, Security, Expo Staff, and Waukesha Kennel Club dog show staff. All private golf carts, utility vehicles, and ATV's must be used around the outer perimeter of the event.**
- Day RV Parking ONLY in Gate #1. No overnight parking will be allowed. Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3.
- Access to Gate #3 – Upon arrival to Gate #3, participants will need to provide a copy of their registration confirmation. Once registration has been verified, a parking pass will be provided to be displayed in the window of the RV. Access to Gate #3 is limited to:
  - o Recreational vehicles with proper parking pass displayed in the window.
  - o Handler/Exhibitor vehicles with proper parking forms displayed in the window. One vehicle per site. Any handler/exhibitors without proper parking confirmations must enter through Gate #1 and use the designated "Handler Drop Off area."
  - o Club members and workers with appropriate pass (Friday – Sunday).
- After 9 p.m., RVs are welcome to enter Gate #3 to be staged in Arena West Parking Lot until the next morning. No electrical hookups available.
- Wednesday (7/25) arrivals are welcome from Noon – 9 p.m.
- A noise curfew is in effect from 10 p.m. until sunrise. This applies to all types of loud noises, including, but not limited to, music and stereos. Please be considerate of your neighbors so everyone can have a pleasant time.
- Grills are allowed by individual RV sites only, not on the show grounds. Hot coals should not be dumped into Expo trash containers or dumpsters. Absolutely NO campfires of any kind will be allowed.
- No tent camping will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on a 6 ft. or less leash, unless in designated dog show rings.
- All campers are responsible for cleaning up and properly disposing of all trash, recyclable items and dog droppings. Please place items in proper receptacles found throughout the Expo Grounds. Failure to follow this rule may result in additional charges or not being allowed to camp on-site for future shows.
- Cancellations of RV Camping and Handler Parking: A full refund will be given if cancelled on or before July 11, 2018. If cancelled July 11, 2018 or later, the reservation fee will be forfeited.

### FSS OPEN SHOW for All Miscellaneous & FSS Breeds JULY 28, 2018

All dogs four (4) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs must be at least 4 months of age on the date of the event.

The following breed classes will be offered at all FSS Open Shows: (All Classes Divide by sex)

4-6 Month Puppy Class	Bred-By-Exhibitor Class
6-9 Month Puppy Class	Open Class
9-12 Month Puppy Class	

## BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

- Dogs less than 4 months of age are ineligible to be on the grounds of licensed or member shows during AKC events.
- Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol (including rabies vaccination) in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.
- Any person acting in the capacity of Show Secretary at an FSS Open Show, or any member of his immediate household or immediate family (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows), shall not exhibit, act as agent or handler at the event, and dogs owned wholly or in part by the show secretary or by any member of their immediate household or immediate family shall be ineligible to be entered at that show.
- No judge or any person residing in the same household with a judge shall exhibit or act as agent or handler at an FSS Open Show at which they are officiating as judge and dogs owned wholly or in part by such judge or any member of their household shall be ineligible to be entered at the show. Subject to the foregoing, members of a judge's immediate family who no longer reside in the same household may enter or handle a dog at a show if the judge is not officiating over any competition, including a group class or Best in Show, for which the dog is entered or may become eligible.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

RAMP BREEDS: Designated ramp breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp during breed judging according to the sole discretion of the judge & not the exhibitor. The entire entry in that breed is to be examined on the ground or on a ramp. Approved ramp breeds: (WHERE APPLICABLE)

Laagott Romagnoli, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels\*, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Basset Hounds\*, Cimechi dell'Enna, Whippets, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs\*, Chinese Shar-Pei\*, Chow Chows\*, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs & Norrbottenspets (misc).

\*By Board approved policy Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei & Chow Chows must be judged on the ramp in all conformation competition associated with AKC conformation dog shows or at which AKC conformation titles may be earned.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Event Secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. This policy extends to Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges - Announcements. Emergencies In emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined

on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

*"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a nose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."*

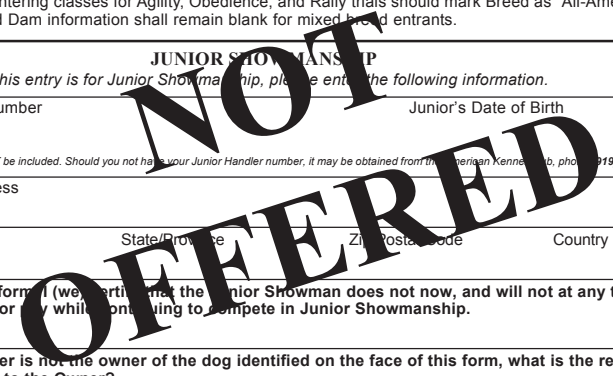
