**NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH SPECIALTY! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE SPECIALTY, ONLY THE FIRST SPECIALTY WILL BE PROCESSED.**

**ENTRY FEE** is \$30.00 for the First Entry of each dog each day. Each additional entry of the same dog will be \$26.00. Veteran Classes are FREE. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class Only is \$30.00. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class as an Additional Entry is \$20.00 (where offered). Sweepstakes is \$26.00, **MUST BE** entered in a Regular class (where offered). JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP Only or as an Additional Entry is FREE (where offered). Obedience & Rally First Entry is \$30.00 and \$26.00 for each additional entry (where offered). Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally and a \$3.00 Fee for each additional entry of the same dog. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

**When a dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class is considered the first entry. ENTRIES CLOSE** at Superintendent's Office, **WEDNESDAY NOON (EDT), SEPTEMBER 20, 2017**, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules or Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations or Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Rally Regulations.

**Note:** Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules states "... Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed.

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION****AWARD OF MERIT** *(offered for the Bulldog Club of America Only)*

At the Judge's discretion, no more than five deserving dogs or bitches, in the Ring for Best of Breed, may receive an Award of Merit. It is not mandatory that the judge award any certificates. Each Judge of Intersex will be given the criteria for such awards. The Award of Merit shall be given following Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite & Selects. A Certificate, Rosette & Bronze High Polished Finish Medal will be awarded to each recipient.

**SPECIAL ATTRACTIONS...** *(offered for the Bulldog Club of America Only)*

**BEST PUPPY**-During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and the 9 mos. and under 12 mos. Classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete**.



**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

*(offered for the Bulldog Club of America & Bulldog Club of America, Division II Only)*

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, none of the dogs making up the entry judged first in their class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won their class.

**STUD DOG CLASS**-shall consist of 2 Get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in placement of the entry, the study dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require a disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. Get must be entered individual in a Regular Class, Best of Breed, or some other Non-Regular class of the same show. Get only to be judged. (Neutered Stud Dogs may be entered.)

**BROOD BITCH CLASS**-shall consist of 2 Produce. Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. (Spayed Brood Bitches may be entered.)

A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS**-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS**-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS**-For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS**-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS**-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS**-This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
