EXHIBITOR EQUIPMENT & RING SET UP

No exhibitor equipment may be brought into the Expo Center until the ring is completely set up on Friday, April 26, 2019. Doors will be opened for exhibitor equipment when the ring set up is complete. Exhibitors are encouraged to volunteer to help with event set up which will mean exhibitors will have access to the site that much sooner.

We truly appreciate all of the help we can get.

SOMETHING NEW PRACTICE RING

Want to give that puppy some ring practice, get him or her used to the surroundings he will be showing in on Saturday? Good for older dogs too! Allows them to stretch their legs after traveling in a crate.

On Friday night, April 26 (the night before the SAMI specialty) we will have a **Practice ring**. You can sign up on Friday night with Jeanne Nonhof and ring time will commence once the ring is set up. The cost is \$5.00 for 5 minutes per dog. In your 5 minutes, you can practice whatever you want, gaiting, stacking, baiting, etc. You can invite another person in to direct the training and go over the dog. You are renting ring time. If you want a second round, that will be allowed after all of the other people who want to participate have had their chance.

ENTRY FEES

Stud Dog (Get MUST BE entered in a Regular Class), Brood Bitch (where offered) (Produce MUST BE entered in a Regular Class) \$30.00 for the first entry and \$20.00 as an additional entry. Brace Class (as a unit) & Team Class (as a unit) ONLY is \$30.00 or \$20.00 as an additional entry (where offered). Sweepstakes (MUST BE entered in a Regular Class) Working Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes (NEED NOT BE entered in a Regular Class) (where offered) is \$20.00 for each event. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY (where offered) or as an additional entry is FREE for each event. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be in the possession of exhibitors or handlers for all dogs at these events.

• NOTE •

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

- The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 A.M. each day. Equipment may be brought in on Friday, after ring is set up until 7:00 P.M.
- Effective January 1, 2010: All dogs must be individually registered with either the AKC or a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration in order to participate in any AKC Conformation, Performance, or Companion event.
- These clubs DO NOT agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.
- **Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs inside & outside of the show site.**

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

AWARD OF MERIT

At the discretion of the judge, an Award of Merit may be given to 10% (always rounded downward) of all those competing for Best of Breed. The 10% figure shall be based on the total Best of Breed entry at the time of closing. i.e. disregarding absentees or transfers from the classes, plus two for Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, plus an additional number for each winner of the following classes: Veteran Dog, 8-10 yrs.; Veteran Dog 10-12 yrs. & Veteran Dog 12 yrs & over; Veteran Bitch, 8-10 yrs. and Veteran Bitch 10-12 yrs. & Veteran Bitch 12 yrs. & over, Working Dog and Working Bitch. All of those in Best of Breed Competition shall be eligible to receive an Award of Merit, except the Best of Breed winner, Select Dog Winner, Select Bitch Winner and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winner.

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES*(Team Class Only offered for Saturday Both Shows)*

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class-For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed/Variety Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Stud Dog to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Neutered Stud Dogs are eligible for entry in this class.

Brood Bitch Class-Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Spayed Brood Bitches are eligible for entry in this class.

Brace Class-For two dogs owned and/or co-owned by the exhibitor. Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Brace will require a fee see Page 2 as a unit, provided the dogs are entered in another class. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each such dog on an individual regular entry form and a separate fee must be paid for each such dog entered. Dogs comprising the Brace must be named at time of entry. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, they MUST be indicated as "Brace #1, Brace #2, etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

Team Class-Effective January 1, 2005. A team is defined as four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Team MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be a part of a Team is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for "Best of Breed Competition," it must be entered for "Team Only". In making entries for "Team Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as a part of a Team MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes-"Team Class." If more than one Team is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Team must be so designated-"Team No. 1," "Team No. 2," etc. PLEASE SUBMIT TEAM ENTRIES TOGETHER.
