ROUTES TO THE SHOW

FROM DOWNTOWN CHICAGO - Take Kennedy Expressway (I-90) westbound, follow O'Hare Airport turnoff, exit River Road south.

FROM 294 NORTHBOUND - Exit toward O'Hare Airport & River Rd. After paying toll immediately go to far left lane and exit at the left exit which leads to River Rd at the stop and go light. Then turn right (southbound) onto River Rd.

FROM 294 SOUTHBOUND - Exit toward O'Hare Airport. After paying toll into O'Hare, the second exit is Mannheim Rd South, exit there, do the cloverleaf and end up on Mannheim Rd going south. You will cross over a highway almost at once and will immediately turn right onto Kennedy Highway East. Almost at once you will exit again onto River Road South or with I-Pass, exit Balmoral East past Hotels to River Rd.

FROM NORTHWEST TOLLWAY - From the north and west should be exited onto 294 South and immediately exited to O'Hare Airport. After paying the toll into O'Hare, exit at once onto Mannheim Rd going south. You will cross over a highway immediately and then must turn right onto Kennedy Highway East. Almost at once you will exit again onto River Road South.

VIA EDENS EXPRESSWAY FROM NORTH (EAST) - Merge onto the Kennedy Expressway Eastbound. Follow O'Hare cutoffs. Exit River Road South.

FROM O'HARE AIRPORT - Take Kennedy Expressway I-90 eastbound 1 1/2 miles. Exit River Rd south.

NOTE: The indoor unloading area as well as the parking lot are accessible from River Road only.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Wednesday, December 6, 2017 the Show Site will be available to exhibitors from **2:00 pm to 10:00 pm**. Each morning the Building will be available at **6:00 am** each morning & will be locked at **10:00 pm** each night. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday, December 10, 2017.

*** Proof of entry required.** 1 person per dog will be allowed entry with no charge. **Spectator Gate will be enforced.**

PLEASE NOTE: While we are back in "A" Hall on the north side of the building, entrance to the unloading is from the south side of the building off River Road. Follow the building around until you come to "C" Hall Overhead Door. Pull inside to unload/load. ALL VEHICLES INSIDE BUILDING MUST HAVE FLASHERS ON WITH IGNITION OFF.

ANY vehicle left longer than 15 minutes will be ticketed & towed at owner's expense.

Those with a handicap sticker, contact Kevin Kelly by 11/23/17 for a limited alternate parking arrangement. Parking will be by direction only. \$15.00 per car or van (subject to change).

After unloading drive to parking garage on the west side of River Road and walk or take shuttle across to main entrance of convention center. Dogs are accepted on the shuttle bus.

There is a driveway to the front door. There is to be absolutely no parking in this area or in the driveway.

ALL VIDEOTAPING during the shows requires Club permission.

THERE WILL BE grooming areas designated for exhibitors. Please cooperate by using these areas and these areas only. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF EXERCISE PENS PER EXHIBITOR OR HANDLER. **PLASTIC MUST BE USED UNDER ALL EXERCISE PENS.** Shavings (\$10.00 a bag) and/or plastic tarps (\$10.00) can be purchased at SKOKIE VALLEY KENNEL CLUB, INC. & INTERNATIONAL KENNEL CLUB OF CHICAGO, INC., headquarters. We further ask your cooperation in keeping the show premises clean. **OUR CONTINUED USE OF THE BUILDING DEPENDS ON THIS! BEST PUPPY-During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and the 9 mos. and under 12 mos. Classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete**.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR-During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in each Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred By Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner **may not compete**.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

A RECORDING FEE of 50¢, and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes will be collected. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2, American Kennel Club Obedience Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 9 & Tracking Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). Rally Trial or Agility Trial will have a \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on the first entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5 & Agility Trial Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 27) These Fees are to be collected by the Show-Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

IF, BECAUSE OF RIOTS, CIVIL DISTURBANCES, OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE MANAGEMENT IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR TO COMPLETE THIS SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEE WILL BE MADE. Emergencies In emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing his entry and receiving a refund).

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
