The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked car or crate, and all persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club for such removal. The Club regards the health, safety, and life of any dog on the show grounds to be paramount to other property or privacy rights. We will not page anyone. We will act!
Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress, or in harm's way (for example, left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress, or harm's way is considered mistreatment and subject to appropriate discipline.

PLEASE HELP KEEP THE GROUNDS & BUILDINGS CLEAN

Show attendees are responsible for cleaning up after the animals in their care. "Poop Stations" with plastic bags and trash cans will be located in the designated dog walking areas and will be patrolled on a regular basis. There will be numerous trash receptacles and cleaning equipment stations in the Grooming Building, and everyone is encouraged to keep his/her area free of accumulated dog hair and other trash. Absolutely no grooming (bathing, trimming, powdering, etc.) will be permitted in any hotel guest room. Everyone's cooperation in taking care of the show site will be greatly appreciated.

DOG HEALTH

The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or any other cause, in accordance with AKC Rules and Regulations. No one shall have claim or recourse against the Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. or any official thereof.

No dog shall be eligible to compete and will be removed immediately from the show grounds if it:

- Show clinical symptoms of distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, or other communicable disease, or
- Is known to have been in contact with distemper, infectious hepatitis, or other communicable disease, or
- Has been kenneled within 30 days prior to the opening of the show at which there existed distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, or other communicable diseases.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

ADDITIONAL SHOW RULES

The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, in accordance with AKC rules and regulations. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. or any official thereof.

THERE IS NO SPACE provided for unentered dogs.

EXHIBITORS ALONE ARE RESPONSIBLE for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be subject to Bench Show Hearing and be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

NO SMOKING is allowed under any show/grooming tent where the dog show is conducted. This is by order of the Frankenmuth Fire Department.

No Grooming (bathing-trimming-powdering etc.) of any dog will be permitted in hotel guest rooms. Violations will be reported to the Event Committee. All hotel sites are under the jurisdiction of the Event Committee.

Dog Washing Stations with warm water for bathing will be provided outside on the show grounds.

GROOMING HOURS – Unless specified differently in the Judging Program or posted at the show, the Reserved Grooming Areas will be available for set up on Sunday, April 29, by 3:00 p.m. The Non-Reserved Grooming Area will be available for set up by 5:00 p.m. The grooming buildings will be open from 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. daily, with the exception of Thursday. On Thursday evening, the Kern Pavilion will close for grooming during the Top 20/10, 6:00 p.m. -9:30 p.m., and will reopen after the Top 20/10 and remain open until 10:30 p.m. There will be NO security personnel on duty overnight in the grooming areas.

Street parking is not permitted by the Kern Pavilion. Observe the "No Parking" signs and park in designated parking areas only. All fire lanes will be strictly enforced.



FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

Judge: Ms. Denise Linda Castonguay

The Four-To-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition shall be for Newfoundlands that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

- A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the Judges' decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, Team & Maturity Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won this class. Dogs & Bitches entered in these classes **MAY** be spayed or neutered, but if so, are not eligible to compete in the Regular Classes.

STUD DOG CLASS-Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs **MUST BE** entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS-Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.



BRACE CLASS-Two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST BE named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for "BRACE CLASS ONLY", full particulars must be given for each dog on INDIVIDUAL REGULAR ENTRY FORMS. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

TEAM CLASS-Four Newfoundlands must have at least one common owner and be presented by a maximum of four(4) handlers. The dogs comprising the team must be named at the time of entry. If a dog member of the team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Team Class Only". Full information for each dog must be given on the Regular Entry Form.

MATURITY CLASS-Entry will be as one unit. Each entry is comprised of one dog or one bitch from each of a three-generation pedigree. Unit to be judged on the merits of all three generations. ALL MUST BE entered in a regular or non-regular class. Neutered or spayed Newfoundlands are eligible. Entries MUST BE made on the regular entry form and accompanied by the Maturity Form provided within this premium. There can be no substitutions.
