ENTRY FEES-FOR EACH DAY & LIMITS

NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE EVENT, ONLY THE FIRST EVENT WILL BE PROCESSED.

ENTRY FEE is \$29.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event except for Puppy Classes which are \$25.00 for each event. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$23.00 for each event. Junior Showmanship is \$21.00 for each event if entered for 'Junior Showmanship Only' or if an Additional Entry; \$11.00 for each event. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

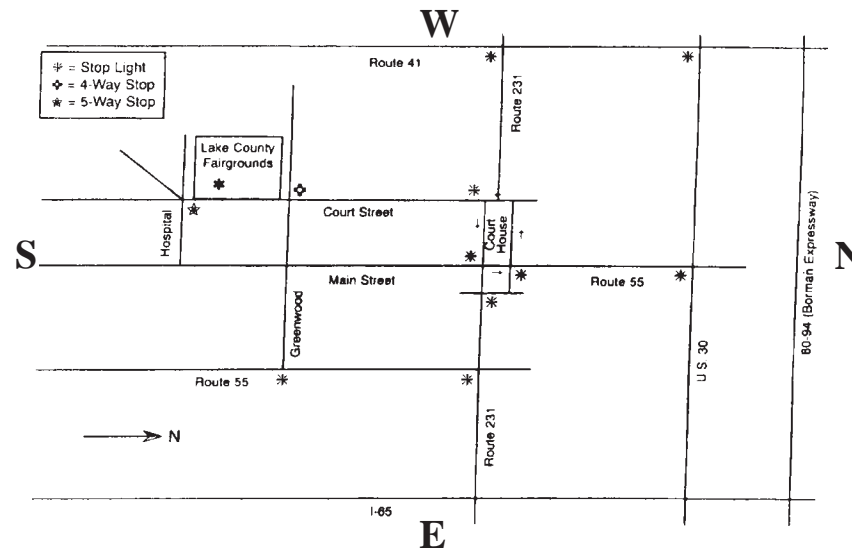

The above provisions for leaving dogs in the Lake County Fairgrounds overnight is a provision of the Clubs for the convenience of the exhibitors. WATCHMEN WILL BE ON DUTY 24 HOURS, but it must be distinctly understood that the presence of these watchmen is a courtesy to exhibitors for the Clubs, their members, directors, officers, agents, show superintendent, and the said employees of the said kennel club and/or its superintendents will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through the loss, theft, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event whether said loss, theft, injury and/or death is or are caused by the negligence or carelessness of the said Kennel Clubs, their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, and/or employees of the said Kennel Clubs and/or employees of their superintendents or by negligence of any person or any other cause.
- NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE RESTROOMS OR OTHER DESIGNATED AREAS.
- DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged or in the exercise pens provided.
- THE LAKE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS will be available on Friday and Saturday nights for exhibitors who wish to leave their dogs in the building overnight. The building will be locked promptly at 10:00 P.M. each night and will not reopen until 6:00 A.M. the following morning.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
