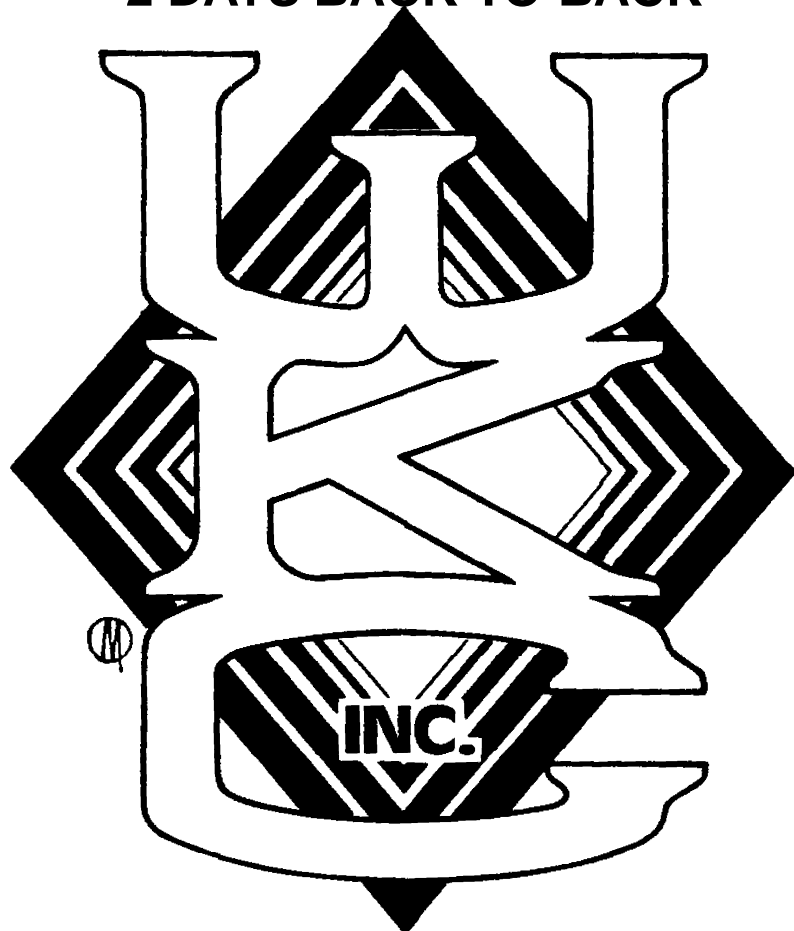

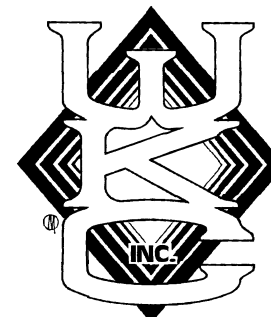

SHOW HOURS EACH DAY 6:30 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. - CST

Dogs are not required to be at the show until scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. Dogs in crates can be brought to the Wisconsin Exposition Center after 12:00 P.M. Friday and overnight. Exhibitors & Handlers must be out of building by 10:00 P.M. Friday & Saturday nights. Show site will again be available at 6:30 A.M. Saturday & Sunday mornings.

ENTRY FEES - FOR EACH DAY

NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH DAY! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE DAY, ONLY THE FIRST DAY WILL BE PROCESSED!

ENTRY FEE is \$29.50 for the first entry of each dog, except for Puppy Classes and Bred by Exhibitor Classes which are \$22.50 each. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$22.50. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP is \$16.00 if an Additional Entry; \$29.50 if entered for Junior Showmanship Only. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

ENTRIES CLOSE at Superintendent's Office, **WEDNESDAY NOON (EST), FEBRUARY 15, 2012**, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules or Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. **OBEDIENCE ENTRIES CLOSE** at Superintendent's Office, **WEDNESDAY NOON (EST), FEBRUARY 15, 2012**, unless limits are reached prior to this date.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

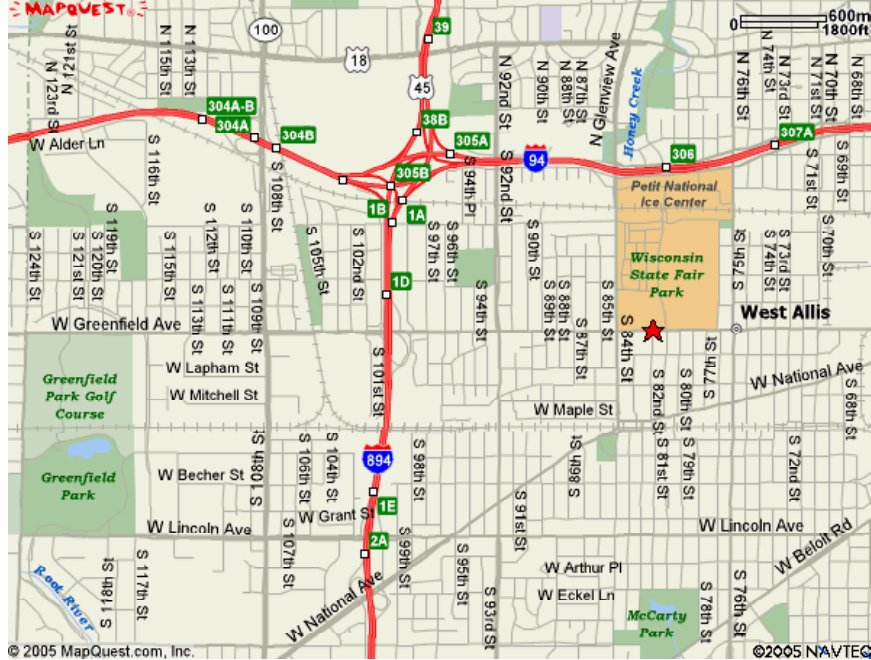
Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

• NOTE •

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS-For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS-This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.
